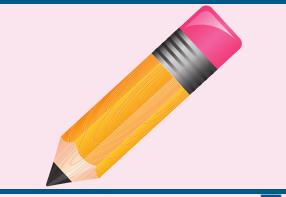

ASK YOUR CHILD IF **29** THERE ARE ANY RECTANGLES IN HIS OR HER CLASSROOM. HINT - DOOR, TABLE, ETC.. WHAT ARE SOME OTHER SHAPES OF ITEMS?

SOME SPACES IN **30** THE CLASSROOM ARE LIMITED TO JUST ONE OR TWO CHILDREN. ASK YOUR CHILD HOW THEY TAKE TURNS WITH FRIENDS.

TODAY IS THE **31** LAST DAY OF AUGUST. WHAT MONTH STARTS TOMORROW?
