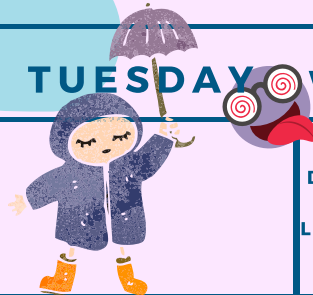
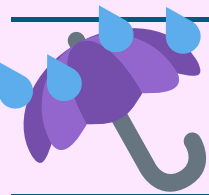

GO TO THE LIBRARY AND CHECK OUT BOOKS ABOUT WEATHER!

PUT DROPS OF PAINT ON PAPER. HAVE CHILDREN BLOW PAINT DROPS AROUND THE PAPER THROUGH THE STRAWS LIKE THE WIND!

THE STUDY OF WEATHER IS CALLED METEOROLOGY. THE PERSON THAT STUDIES WEATHER IS CALLED A METEOROLOGIST. WHERE CAN WE FIND A METEOROLOGIST?

DOCUMENT THE WEATHER EACH DAY THIS MONTH. JUST WRITE OR DRAW RAIN, WIND, CLOUDS, SUN. PREDICT THE WEATHER FOR THE NEXT 2 DAYS.

WHAT KIND OF LINES DOES THE LETTER 'F' HAVE? CURVY, STRAIGHT OR BOTH? THINK ABOUT UPPER AND LOWER CASE!

NOTICE HOW MANY TIMES METEOROLOGISTS USE NUMBERS DURING THE NEWS. WHAT DO THOSE NUMBERS TELL US?

RETURN THE BOOKS TO THE LIBRARY AND CHECK OUT MORE!

IMAGINE WHAT IT IS LIKE TO PAINT WITH CLOUDS! USE COTTON BALLS TO PAINT!

CHECK THE WEATHER EACH MORNING THIS WEEK TO FIND OUT WHAT THE TEMPERATURE DAILY. WRITE IT NEXT TO THE WEATHER ON THIS CALENDAR.

YOU MIGHT USE A COMPUTER, OR TELEVISION TO CHECK THE TEMPERATURE. WHAT IS THE INSTRUMENT NAMED TO MEASURE TEMPERATURE?

LOOK THROUGH YOUR CHECKED-OUT LIBRARY BOOKS FOR THE LETTER F. HOW MANY CAN YOU FIND?

SOMETIMES WEATHER CAN BE SEVERE. WHAT IS YOUR FAMILY'S WEATHER SAFETY PLAN? HOW DOES YOUR CHILD KNOW TO BE SAFE?
